Effective Date: March 15, 2018

World of Outlaws Craftsman Late Models / DIRTcar Late Models:

15.11 - Rear Suspension & Suspension Components

- A General
- e. Bump sticks are not allowed anywhere on the car in 2018. They will be reevaluated in September 2018 for consideration of approval for the 2019 season.

15.12 - Wheels

H – Wheel/Air Bleeders are not allowed anywhere on the car in 2018. They will be reevaluated in September 2018 for consideration of approval for the 2019 season.

Effective Date: April 20, 2018

World of Outlaws Craftsman Late Models / DIRTcar Late Models:

15.10.3 - Nosepiece

- L. Right Side Nose Height Rule The maximum height from the ground to the top of the nose splitter shall be 15 inches.
 - M. Front Nose must be mounted in the center of the car

15.10.6 - Front Fenders, Fender Flares and Hood

J. – The front fender may be a maximum of 37"-inches in height, measured vertically from the ground to the top of the fender behind the front tires <u>and at the right front fender and door area at the T-Bar.</u>

15.10.8 - Quarter Panels

G. The maximum height from the ground to the top of the rear deck at the top of the rear quarter panel is 39"-inches.

Some of these rules may already be reflected in the 2018 rulebook, it is a reminder of the guidelines that will be used when inspecting cars.

All cars will be subject for inspection at any point during an event.
