What is the Firecracker 100?

Celebrating its 12th anniversary, the Firecracker 100 is a crown jewel event in dirt Late Model racing. Get ready for three nights of non-stop thrill racing and an incredible array of family-friendly events that allow fans of all ages to interact with their favorite drivers. Three nights, three complete shows, capped off by the 100-lap, \$30,000-to-win Firecracker 100 Feature.

When is it?

Thursday, Friday and Saturday, June 21-23, 2018.

Where is the track located?

Lernerville Speedway is located at 313 N. Pike Rd., Sarver, PA 16055.

Is Reserved Seating available?

Yes, the majority of the grandstands is designated as Reserved Seating. You can purchase advanced tickets online by clicking the "[Buy Tickets](#)" button on the schedule page at woolms.com/schedule, visiting outlawtix.com, or by calling 1-844-DIRT-TIX (347-8849). General Admission tickets are also available for purchase at the Lernerville Speedway office. Advanced Reserved Packages include a **FREE Fan Pit Pass** for Thursday and Friday nights.



How do I buy a ticket?

How much are advanced tickets?

We offer various packages:

- Three-Day Packages:
 - Three-day Reserved Ticket Package is \$69.00 for adults, \$45.00 for students & children (17 and under)
 - Three-day General Admission Ticket Package is \$69.00 for adults, \$45.00 for students (11-17), and children (10 and under) are FREE.
 - Three-day Pit Pass is \$90.00 for members, \$95.00 for non-members.
- Thursday- or Friday-only Ticket:
 - \$34.00 for Reserved/General Admission adult
 - \$30.00 for Reserved/General Admission student (11-17)
 - FREE for Children (10 and under) in G.A. ONLY; \$30.00 for Reserved.
 - Thursday or Friday Pit Pass: \$35.00 non-members, \$30.00 for members.
- Saturday-only Tickets:
 - \$40.00 for Reserved /General Admission adults
 - \$25.00 for Reserved/General Admission students (11-17)
 - FREE for children (10 and under) in G.A. ONLY; \$25.00 for Reserved.
 - Saturday Pit Pass: \$40.00

DON'T FORGET: You also get a **FREE Fan Pit Pass** for Thursday and Friday night with every Reserved Package you buy in Advance. Don't miss out on this great opportunity.

Will I still be able to purchase tickets the day of the event?

Yes, you will be able to purchase tickets the day of the race at the Main Ticket Booth at Lernerville Speedway. Tickets are selling fast, so get yours soon, before it's too late.

Can I purchase a Pit Pass in advance?

Eligibility for the valuable insurance benefits and money-saving discounts offered to DIRTcar Members are verified in person, therefore Pit Passes are sold the day of show only. Pit Passes must be purchased in person at the Pit Window. Once there, you will be required to sign a Waiver and Release of Liability and will be issued a wristband.

What is the age limit for the pit area?

There is not an age limit for the pit area at this event. Minors 17 and younger must submit a fully-executed minor "Parental Consent, Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement/Minor's Assumption of Risk and Release and Waiver of Liability." These will be available at the Pit Ticket Windows.

Can I upgrade my ticket to get a Pit Pass?

Yes, a Pit Pass upgrade will be \$10.00 for adults.

Is camping available?

Of course! With so much excitement going on, you're never going to want to leave the track grounds. Camping will be \$75 for the entire weekend or \$25 a day. We offer a variety of camping packages to suit all types of parties. There will be family-friendly and party-friendly reserved areas as well as the always popular trackside camping. Call 724-353-1511 for details on reserving your spot today. Firewood and ice will also be readily available at the track for purchase.

Who is performing in concert?

The Firecracker always includes a concert following Thursday and Friday's show. This year's concert on Thursday will be Tim Litvin and Friday night will be Bridgewater Station.

Will there be a fireworks show?

We don't call it the Firecracker 100 for nothing! Of course there will be a fireworks show. You're not going to want to miss this spectacular one-of-a-kind concert-style fireworks and pyrotechnic display. We will be lighting up the sky all weekend long.

What is happening Wednesday before the Firecracker 100?

How do I sign up for Cornhole and Horseshoe Tournament?

Tournaments will take place Friday at 1:00 pm in front of the concert stage

Are coolers permitted?

Small "personal size" coolers are permitted at Lernerville Speedway as long as they contain no glass containers and no alcoholic beverages. Alcohol must be left at the campsite or purchased inside the race track.

Will Pits be open after the race?

Yes, the Pits will be open after the completion of all on-track activities on Saturday night. Fans can see their favorite drivers and cars up close and in person!

Where can I find the Official Entry Application?

Official Entry Applications are available for download on the [Firecracker 100 page](#) of the [Lernerville Speedway website](#) or by calling the Lernerville Speedway office at 704-353-1511. Drivers can also pick up entry forms at the Pit Board any Friday night.

What is the purse?

The purse is \$6,000-to-win both Thursday and Friday nights. Saturdays "Uncle Sam" Feature will be a \$3,000-to-win, and finishing off the night will be a \$30,000-to-win Feature.

What is the process of requesting media credentials?

Directions

PA Turnpike to Exit 48 (Allegheny Valley Exchange) through toll booth bear right before third traffic light go right follow signs to Rt. 28 (Allegheny Expressway) north to Exit 17 (Rt. 356 Freeport) at stop sign turn right - go 4 1/2 miles track on right.

Interstate 80 West to Interstate 79 south follow to Exit 29 Route 422 go east to Route 8 south through Butler then follow signs to Rt. 356. Lernerville is 11- miles south of Butler Rt. 356 on left.

From Either Rt. 22 or Rt. 30 West to Rt. 66-follow Rt. 66 north to Rt. 356- past Freeport north continue Rt. 356 - track 5 miles on right.

FROM SOUTH

Only 30 minutes from Downtown Pittsburgh take Rt. 28 (Allegheny Valley Expressway) north to Exit 17 (Rt. 356 Freeport) at stop sign-turn right and go north on (Rt. 356) 4 1/2 miles track on right.

Follow Interstate 79 north to Cranberry Twp. Exit 78 Mars, PA- Rt. 228 follow Rt. 228 east about 20 miles carefully watching Rt. 228 East signs until Rt. 356-left onto Rt. 356-2 miles track on right.

FROM NORTH

Follow Interstate 79 south to Exit 29 - Route 422 east to Route 8 south through Butler then follow signs to Rt. 356. Lernerville is 11 miles south of Butler Rt. 356 on left.

FROM WEST

PA Turnpike to Exit 28 Cranberry, PA through toll booth following signs to Interstate 79 north – go one to Exit #78 Mars - Rt. 228 east about 20 miles carefully watching Rt. 228 east signs until you reach Rt. 356 –left onto Rt. 356 – 2 miles track on right.

Route 422 East to Butler Rt. 8 exit – go south through town then follow signs to Route 356 south. Lernerville Speedway is 11 miles south of Butler on Rt. 356 on left.

USING BONNIEBROOK ROAD (Off of Rt. 422)

Follow Rt. 422 past all three Butler Exits at the first Traffic light turn right onto Bonniebrook-go straight thru first stop sign. At second stop sign (yellow manufacturing buildings) turn left onto Rt. 356 – track is about 4 miles south on left.
